Rewards and Recognition:

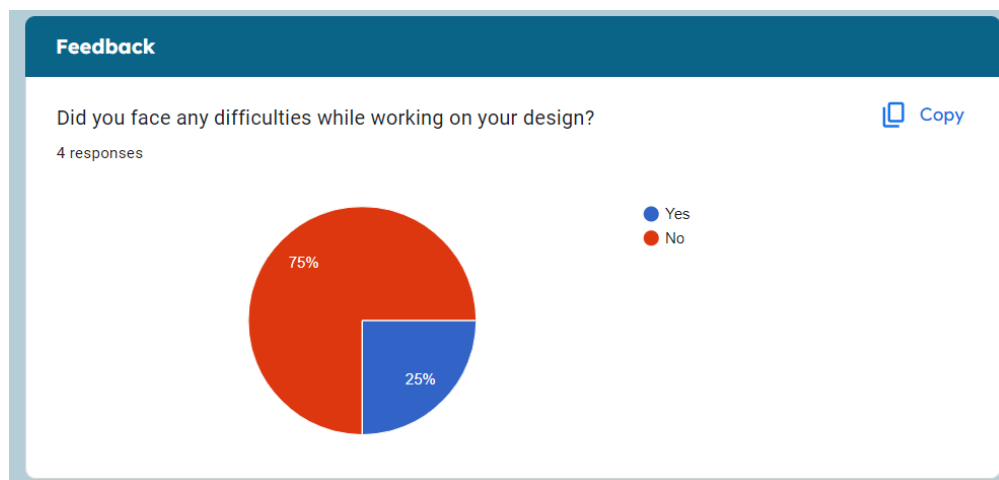

Feedback

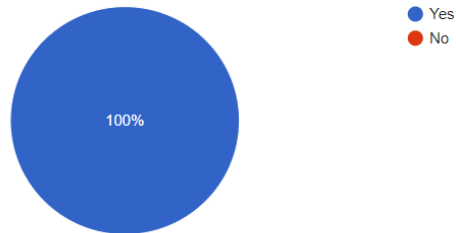
Participants were invited to share their feedback on the competition's organization, rules, and overall experience. Feedback forms were distributed to gather insights for future events and improvements.

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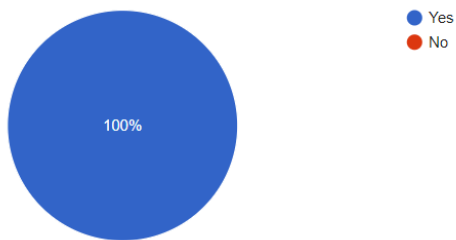

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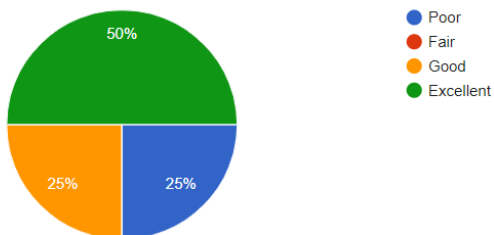

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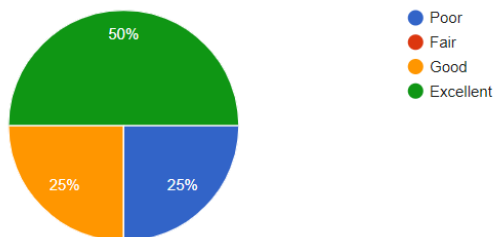
